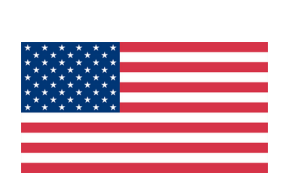

## Hollins University

Hollins University will expand its study abroad offerings through the creation of programs in Kenya focused on women's rights and public health. These programs will examine comparative health systems between the United States and Kenya and enhance students' knowledge of women's health advocacy in both countries.

## Baldwin Wallace University

Baldwin Wallace University's (BWU) "Computing in Guatemala" program successfully increased study abroad participation among BWU computer science (CS) students by internationalizing a software engineering capstone course and expanding opportunities for students to study in Central America. CS students collaborated with a nonprofit organization, Mission Guatemala, to develop, deploy, and maintain a custom medical record software system for the non-profit's health clinic.

## The College of New Jersey

The College of New Jersey will advance an existing collaboration with the Pravara Institute of Medical Sciences in India to develop joint curricula, virtual course components, and international faculty-led field experiences focused on global health, which will equip American and Indian faculty and students with comparative nursing, public health, and kinesiology skills.
